General Supplies:

- 1 digital or paper planner with room for at least 5 classes per day

- 1 3-subject spiral bound notebook (Math)
- Lined loose-leaf notebook paper (wide rule)
- 1 lined composition book - not spiral bound (Language Arts)
- 1 graph paper composition book – not spiral bound (Math)
- 1 graph paper composition book – not spiral bound (Science)
- Package of small Post-It notes (Language Arts)
- Pencils (enough to last your child the year)
- Erasers (enough to last your child the year)
- 12 Pens (4 black, 4 blue, 4 red)
